CHANGING OF SUNDAY MASS SCHEDULE

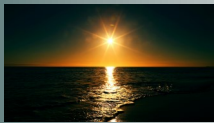
New Programme:

when we are afraid, lose courage and give up,

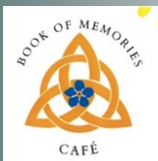
when we see our dreams broken,
