LENT 2026 let us be courageous witnesses to the example of Jesus by imitating His wilderness or desert experience which he undertook before he began the three years of his public mission which ultimately led him to Jerusalem and his Passion, Death and Resurrection! As he prayed, we pray; as he fasted, we fast, as he gave of himself and took on the Gospel mission, we give of our charity and take on renewed Christian purpose! Set aside an extra bit of time for prayer, daily Mass, or charity work. Maybe set up a sacred space/altar in your home with the Bible at the centre and use the Trocaire Box as a visible reminder of how fortunate we are and of what we can share with those whose needs are greater. And of course we traditionally give up some favourite foods/sweets or even T.V., iPad or Social Media time as a way of fasting for Lent! As Catholics we are asked to abstain from meat every Friday and if possible every Wednesday, you might consider this for Lent!

Make time with everyone at home to pray the Rosary for peace in our troubled world. Visit the church for quiet time of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Consider attending daily Mass.

Open the Bible for Gospel reflection.

Make the Stations of the Cross on Fridays or whenever suits.

Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation: Confessions after 10am Mass on Saturday mornings.

Invite a relative or friend who hasn't been for a while to come with you to Mass.

Invite your spouse or family or even a friend to join with you in doing these Lenten suggestions. Whatever crosses you may be carrying, please come and place your pain or burden or affliction or addiction before Jesus, as we make this journey of Lent 2026.

Blessed ashes will be available on Ash Wednesday in all our churches. If you are unable to attend Mass try to visit a church during the day; pray before the Cross as we begin the journey of Lent, seeking the merciful love of God
