40 Hours Adoration at the Cathedral celebrating this Jubilee Year of Hope

Eucharistic Adoration is taking place in the Cathedral of Christ the King, Mullingar, from next Friday 21st to Sunday 23rd November, the Solemnity

of Christ the King. Adoration begins after Mass on Friday evening and concludes at 4 pm with sung Vespers and Benediction on the Sunday, with Bishop Alan Mc Guckian SJ, Bishop of Down and Connor, as homilist. There will be confessions available during Adoration. Each parish within the Pastoral Areas of the Diocese have been invited to spend one hour in Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. Our parish and the Kells pastoral area will have it's hour on Saturday 22nd November at 7pm. Everyone is invited to participate in this diocesan pilgrimage of prayer; praying for vocations, for families preparing for the Sacraments, and for peace in our world. A bus for our Pastoral Area will leave St. Colmcille's Church, Kells at 5pm. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
