MORNING PRAYER OF THE CHURCH

CHURCH HEATING

Following on from the Heat Efficiency Report conducted by Ronan Meally Consulting Engineers in October 2022 and our ongoing efforts to implement better practice as suggested in the report, having already altered the vent system in the wooden panels, insulated all the pipe work in the boiler house and now doing an annual boiler service - these measures have resulted in a notable improvement. However the findings in the report is that we have up to 40% heat loss mainly due to the wooden panels completely covering the front of the radiators which is acting as a barrier, nullifying the radiating of heat and therefore having a negative effect on heat output. This is also making the heating system more expensive to run as the boiler will work harder / take longer to reach the temperature set by the thermostat.

Works are now been undertaken to rectify this and hopefully achieve a warmer church while at the same time making a cost saving on oil with the boiler then being on for a shorter duration. Also there's the added benefit of reducing our carbon footprint by cutting back on the burning of fossil fuels.

PLANNED RE-LOCATION of the beautiful statue of St. Colmcille, previously stored alongside The Book of Kells and now moving to a more prominent and visible space in Main Entrance Porch, highlighting St. Colmcille and telling something of his story.
