REPORT OF THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS HELD IN ROME IN OCT 2023

Unlike previous Synods, this Synod included 70 lay men and women and religious all with voting rights. Divided into groups of 10, each person was given 4 minutes to speak followed by a period of silence. Second round each got 4 minutes to say what had struck them while listening. Again a period of silence. Third round exploring together what they felt God was saying to them so they could present their findings to the whole assembly.

If booking a number of shows together we would ask for a €10 deposit per show rather than full payment at booking.



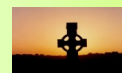
