**GUIDELINES FOR OPENING OF KELLS AND GIRLEY
CHURCHES ON JUNE 29TH**

If the 2 metre distance is maintained, Kells church will accommodate 120 people and Girley 40. (If the distance is reduced to 1 metre then the numbers will be 180 and 50 respectively). So, to offset this reduction in numbers, we are bringing in extra Masses. Starting from Mon June 29th the daily Mass times will be as follows:-

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

To accommodate the families whose baptisms had to be postponed, there will be baptisms each Sunday during July at 2pm. A maximum of 4 babies will be baptised each Sunday and we ask families to limit those attending to 20 per family.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (Confession)

Opportunities for the sacrament resume on Sat 4th July at the usual times. Both confession rooms have been adapted to allow for physical distancing and sanitising.
