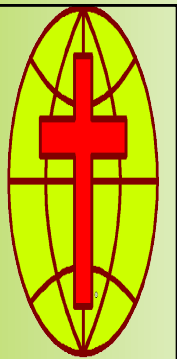

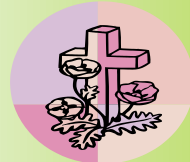

The Offertory Plate Collection at all Masses this Sunday will also be part of our Mission Sunday collection.

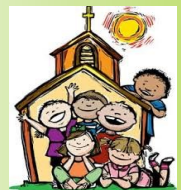


LIST OF THE DEAD
