

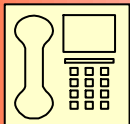

VOCATIONS SUNDAY 25TH APRIL 2021

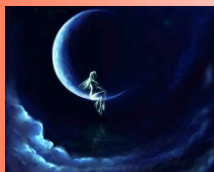
