**The Candidate**

The successful candidate, besides having secretarial skills, should be a person of faith, keen and enthusiastic to promote the Gospel, with skills especially suited to developing the faith of young people. The person should possess good inter-personal skills and have the confidence to provide leadership to young people. The successful candidate should be organised, trustworthy, discreet and respectful of confidentiality. An aptitude and desire for working with young people is essential.

**The Role**

Directly supporting and working alongside the Parish Groups and Priests. This position is being offered from November 8th 2021 to June 3rd 2022 averaging a 20 hour week where there can be some flexibility around the hours to suit both candidate and employer. The first six weeks will be a probationary period.

The post covers a wide range of duties and includes:

- Provision of secretarial/administrative support to the Parish in all its different aspects;
- Preparation and copying of the weekly Parish Bulletin;
- Maintenance of Parish Diaries & Records.
- Keeping records of all income and expenditure including monitoring of bills/invoices, statements etc for payment;
- Management of Parish website, Parish e-mail and Parish Database;
- Liaising with local schools and young people in relation to sacramental preparation and programmes;
- Assisting in the organisation and delivery of retreat work.
- Organising youth social activity groups across the age divides.
- Other duties that may be assigned from time to time.

**Experience and Qualifications**

Have excellent computer skills, including a good working knowledge of Microsoft Word and Excel. Experience in web maintenance and database management would be an advantage.

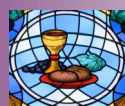
