HONOURING LOCAL SAINT - ST. OLIVER PLUNKETT

400th Anniversary of his Birth & 50th Anniversary of his Canonisation
This year marks two significant anniversaries in the life of the Church in Ireland and the Diocese of Meath: the 400th anniversary of the birth of St. Oliver Plunkett on 1st November 1625 and the 50th anniversary of his canonisation in 1975.

To mark these occasions, Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Tom Deenihan, with the priests of the Diocese of Meath, at Loughcrew, the birthplace of St. Oliver, on Sun 29th June at 3pm. All are welcome to attend this special celebration. Archbishop of Armagh, Primate of All-Ireland, Most Reverend Eamonn Martin, will be the homilist.

The Knights of Columbanus will have the relic of St. Oliver at the 10am Mass in Kells church on the feast day, Tuesday 1st July. All are welcome.
