

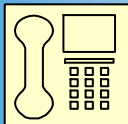

Girley: Sun 10am

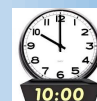
Baptisms will resume from Saturday 15th May. For May & June the schedule of times will be Saturdays 12pm and 5pm, Sundays 1pm.

Amen.

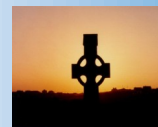
