PLACES OF WORSHIP:

Following Detailed Covid-19 Guidance please see below:-

- Social distancing guidelines: please allow a generous space of 2 metres between you and the next person so that everyone can feel safe and comfortable.
- 4 Coloured-Coded Sections - Orange, Blue, Red and Green - 50 allowed in each distinct section as long as there is at least 4 metres between sections.
Each section must have its own entry/exit route.
No movement of people between sections, before, during or after Mass.

We wish to express our appreciation to Councillor Mike Bray who applied to Meath County Council on behalf of Girley church for a grant to finance the installation of an outdoor loudspeaker. ALONE - manage a national support line and additional supports for older people who have concerns or are facing difficulties relating to the outbreak of COVID-19. Professional staff are available to answer queries and give advice and reassurance where necessary. The support line is open seven days a week, 8am-8pm by calling 0818 222 024.

INSOLVENCY SERVICE OF IRELAND - is the independent government body with four debt solutions to help people with all levels of problem debt - from credit cards to mortgages. It regulates debt advisors called Personal Insolvency Practitioners (PIPs). You could be insolvent if (a) you cannot pay your bills in full when they are due; (b) you are paying a little off each bill trying to keep creditors at bay; (c) you have had calls and letters about missed repayments and threats of repossession. If you are insolvent and in arrears on your home mortgage you could also be eligible for a free consultation with a PIP under the state-funded Abhaile Scheme. The purpose of that scheme is to help people in serious arrears to find the best available solutions, with the help of professional advisors.
