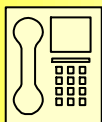

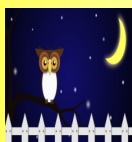

**NEW LETTER FROM POPE FRANCIS - 'FRATELLI TUTTI'**



On October 4th, the feast of St Francis of Assisi, Pope Francis released a new letter entitled '*Fratelli Tutti - On Fraternity and Social Friendship*'. What is it that modern civilisation most lacks? What are the fundamental deficiencies that ultimately could undermine it? Pope Francis has come up with a profound answer that seems at first glance too insubstantial, even naive, to save the world from itself. Not a major source of new energy or fresh food supply; not even a cure for cancer. What the world needs is the realisation that every member of the human race is brother or sister to every other member, no matter how distant or unfamiliar.
