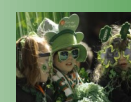
Beannachtaí na Féile Pádraig oraibh

This will be happening in every parish in the world. People from the ten parishes in the Kells area will meet in the Headfort Arms Hotel for three evenings. All parishioners are welcome to come on an evening that suits and, in an attempt to spread the attendance, we have this flexible structure:-

UKRAINE COLLECTION

Needless to say any such money will be spent, in its entirety, alleviating the suffering of the Ukrainian refugees in Romania.
